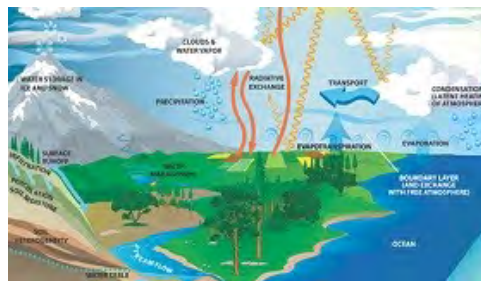




NACO Workshop

The passage of SB150 in the 2019 Legislative Session mandates all cities & counties develop & maintain water resource plans. Those plans must include the analysis of existing & expected water demands in the community, an analysis of the adequacy of identified sources of available water & a plan for obtaining additional water if necessary. This workshop looks at what it takes to put together good water plans & how communities are approaching water planning for the future.
