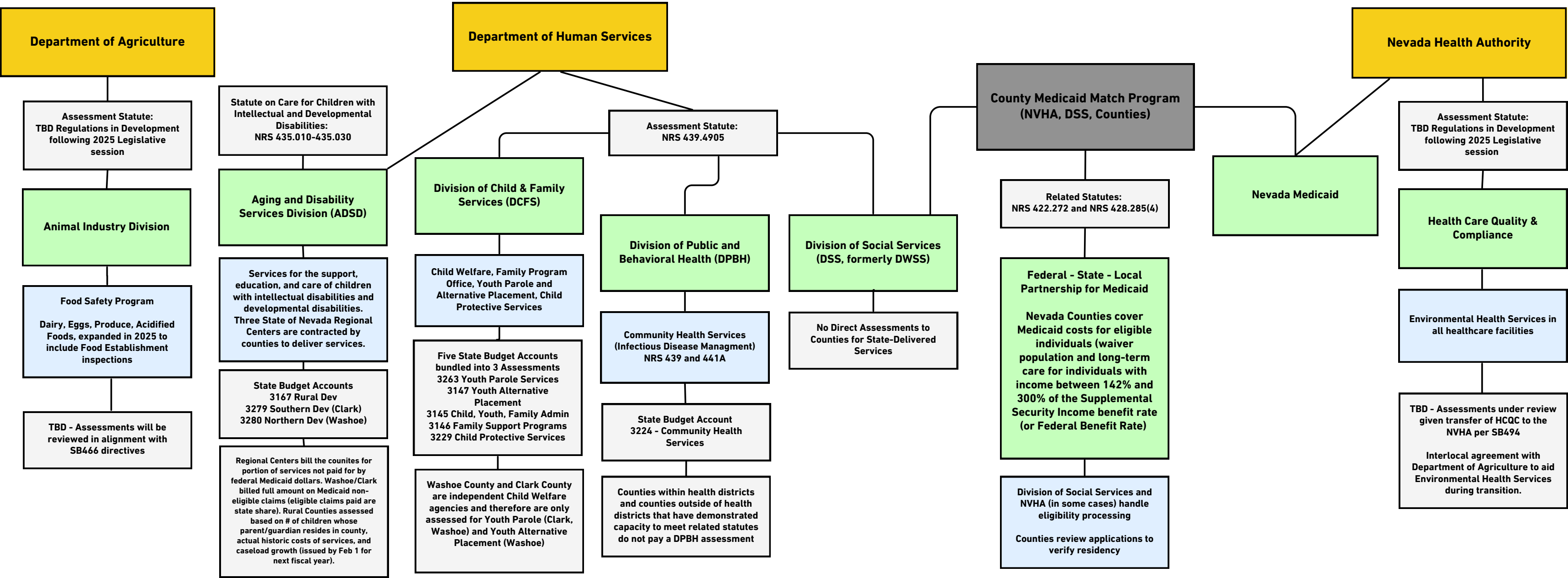


STATE HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES ASSESSMENTS TO COUNTIES & MEDICAID MATCH MAP

Counties in Nevada are assessed for a portion of the cost for some state-delivered services. The initial assessments passed by the Legislature in 2011 were limited to the Department of Health & Human Services. During the 83rd Session of the Nevada Legislature, authority over certain public health services was transferred to additional/new state departments with the authority to assess for services.

While this chart outlines all health-related assessments to counties for state-delivered services, not all counties pay all assessments. Through interlocal agreement or delegation of authority, some of these assessments are removed on a county-by-county basis where counties deliver the services themselves or ensure the delivery of service (such as through joining a local health district or providing child welfare locally).
